

A new replacement name for *Tylenchodorus* Gagarin, 2000 (Nematoda: Tylencholaimidae)

Tylenchodoroides nom. n. is proposed to replace *Tylenchodorus* Gagarin, 2000 preoccupied by *Tylenchodorus* Siddiqi, 1983.

A new replacement name *Tylenchodoroides* is proposed here to replace the name *Tylenchodorus* given by Gagarin (2000, p. 205) to a new genus of nematodes collected from dust of rotten trees in the European part of Russia. This name is preoccupied by the name of the nematode genus *Tylenchodorus* described by Siddiqi (1983) from Colombian rain forest.
