Diogma caudata Takahashi is recorded from the Perm' Prov. of Russia.

Diogma caudata Takahashi, 1960

Material examined. **Russia, Perm' Prov.** ("Molotovsk. obl."): 1 ♂, Kungur, forest station, 16.VI.1960 (Borisova leg.); kept at Zoological Institute, St.Petersburg.

Takahashi (1960) described *Diogma caudata*, a middle-sized (15 mm) crane-fly, from Japan (Hokkaido). Siitonen (1984) recorded this species from Finland (Kuusamo, Oulangan Biological Station). The locality in Russia is intermediate between the two localities known previously and suggests a transpalaeartic distribution of the species under consideration. With this new record, the fauna of Cylindrotomidae of Russia comprises six species.
